## Milford Haven (Daugleddau) Estuary Rally 2012

#### 1 Introduction

The Daugleddau Rally 2012 event is probably the first SBA event in West Wales. It is aimed at Members with salt-water capability since the estuary is salty at the lower end and brackish inland.

This is a new Event, but the organisers have had a trial run in 2011 that was very successful. To minimize the liklihood of problems, the SBA has invited the West Wales Maritime Heritage Society (<a href="http://www.wwmhs.org.uk/">http://www.wwmhs.org.uk/</a>) to join us. Their members have good local knowledge and will join us as passengers or with their own boats.

The Programme is set up to provide a varied, tide dependent, series of boating activities over five days, with one free day in the middle. It is envisaged that attendees will take accommodation in the area for a full week and possibilities are attached with this information sheet.

It is important to remember that the Estuary is both incredibly beautiful but also a working port for super tankers. Thus all navigators are expected to abide by the Port Regulations. This means that we will have to be rather more prescriptive than if this was an event on a canal. You will need to have navigation lights, buoyancy aids, etc. Full details are provided in the Captain's Handbook that will be issued to attendees.

#### Where is the Daugleddau Estuary?

The locals pronounce the name "dai-gleth-aie", and the estuary is in the beautiful county of Pembrokeshire in West Wales. The main town is Pembroke with associated town of Pembroke Dock (ferry to Ireland) and Neyland (I K Brunel's port for his first transatlantic service). ## 3 Rally Base

The Event will probably be based at **Neyland Yacht Haven**, where launching and recovery is free (a public slip). (Neyland Yacht Haven, Brunel Quay, Neyland, Pembrokeshire, SA73 1PY. Telephone: 01646 601601. e-mail: neyland@yacht havens.com) Boats can be moored for the week here at a cost of around £75 per week (£2.00 per metre/day with a minimum charge of £12.80, but this can be reduced by boats shring a berth).

Alternatives are East Llanion Marine, where launching and trailer parking for the week was £10 in 2011, and Dale Sailing Company Ltd, Brunel Quay, Neyland, Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire, SA73 1PY. Telephone: 01646 603110/ 01646 603107 (Fee for 2012 is £5 per trailer per week.).
